About The Film : Kita Kita


Kita Kita (I See You) is a 2017 Philippine romantic comedy film written and directed by Sigrid Andrea P. Bernardo, and starring Alessandra de Rossi and Emroy Marquez. Set in Sapporo, Japan, the film follows Lea (De Rossi), a Filipino tourist guide living in Japan who goes blind having witnessed her Japanese fiancé's infidelity. Afterwhile, fellow Filipino and charmer Tonyo (Marquez) makes a sudden appearance and befriends the visually impaired Lea in best possible ways and eventually they fall for one another.

Her third film KITA KITA (I See You) won various awards locally and has been selected to screen in different film festivals internationally. It was also a huge box office success in the Philippines. Otaru
Otaru Canal 小樽
 Otaru Canal is a 1,140 meter-long canal. The canal at night is a nostalgic time emphasized by the compassionate port town.



Canal Cruise

Otaru Orgel Doh (Music Box Museum)
 The appearance of the Main Building of Music Box Museum was built in 1912. The stained glass and hand-made accessories by Hokkaido artists are very popular.

 The national road 237 connects Asahikawa and Furano is a beautiful drive route. "Zerubunooka Atomunooka" in Biei Town is on the way, which is a very beautiful flower field spot.



Higashikawa 東川
Daisetsuzan Asahidake Ropeway
 The Daisetsuzan Asahidake Ropeway is a ropeway on Mt. Asahidake (height 2291m), the highest peak in Hokkaido.

Other things that you can enjoy in SAPPORO!

Jozeankei
 Hot Springs and Seasonal Activities
 Despite the close proximity to the city, Jozeankei, located just one hour by car from downtown Sapporo, is a healing spot where you can enjoy both rich nature, and soothing hot springs. Hotels full of uniqueness are crowded together inside the hot spring village, and if you go just a bit further, you can take advantage of the many activities offered inside the national park.



Horse Trekking
 Enjoy Western-style horseback riding throughout the year, on trails through pastures and hills.



Canoe/Rafting
 Take in the beautiful canyons as you enjoy canoeing and rafting on the Toyohira River. (April - November)



Walking
 Experience natural beauty and outdoor activities in every season. This is a popular location in Sapporo to admire the fall colors. Between June and October, Nature Luminarie adds a romantic touch to night walks.



Hot Springs

"Sapporo's annex", boasting history and popularity
The spring water flows out from the Toyohira River, and contains naturally occurring sodium chloride, which heats the body from within. In autumn, you can soak in the springs while viewing the foliage, and in winter, you can enjoy watching the snow drift down.



Cuisine

Beer
 Indulge in Sapporo's finest beers.
 The history of beer in Sapporo dates back to 1876, when the government of Hokkaido, the kaitakushi, opened the kaitakushi brewery (the predecessor to the current Sapporo Beer company). Indulge in the history and culture of beer made here in Sapporo, where humidity is low, and the water is absolutely delicious.



Sushi
 Hokkaido is home to a myriad of seafood, and in Sapporo, where fresh seafood from around the island is gathered, you can find many delicious sushi restaurants.



Jingisukan (Lamb BBQ)
 Jingisukan (Lamb BBQ), is a typical dish of Hokkaido, where fresh lamb is barbecued with vegetables in a special pan. Sapporoites enjoy their "jingisukan" with beer at BBQ restaurants.



Ramen
 Sapporo miso ramen is a local cuisine, now a signature food of Japan. Miso flavored ramen originated in Sapporo.



Soup Curry
 Local cuisine of Sapporo, soup curry has a smooth soup made with spices and filled with large chunks of fresh ingredients.



Sweets
 Cakes and soft serve ice cream made from fresh Hokkaido cream and milk are delicacies you can only enjoy on the island.



New Manila-Sapporo Flight By Philippine Airlines

From 10 September, 2018 onwards, Philippine Airlines will begin operating the first-ever nonstop flight between Sapporo and Manila starting September 10, 2018.

The six-hour non-stop flight will operate thrice weekly every Monday, Wednesday and Friday, departing from New Chitose Airport at 1:05 pm and arriving at Manila's Ninoy Aquino International Airport at 5:40 pm.

Sapporo Beer Museum

Sapporo Beer Museum, the only beer museum in Japan, was opened in July of 1987 to provide visitors with a varied knowledge of beer and brewing. It is one of the precious cultural legacies of Meiji Era and has been selected to receive the official 'Hokkaido Heritage' designation.
