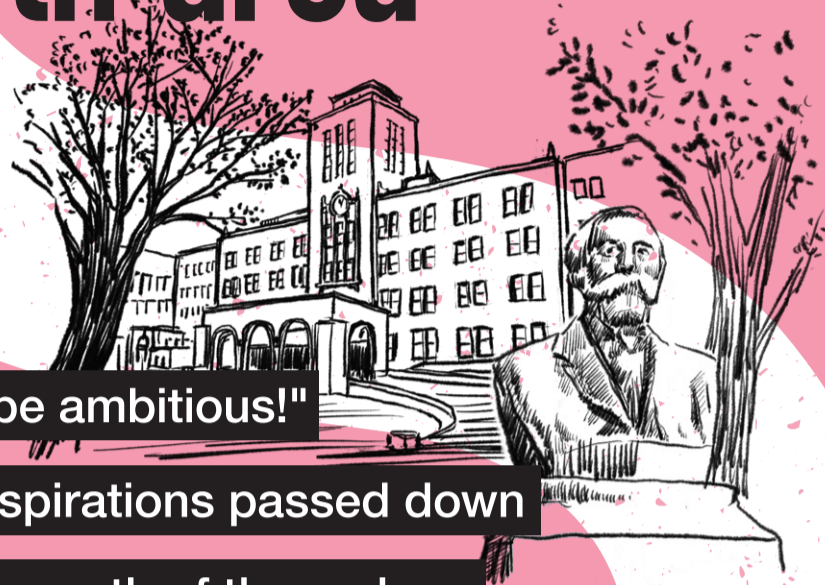

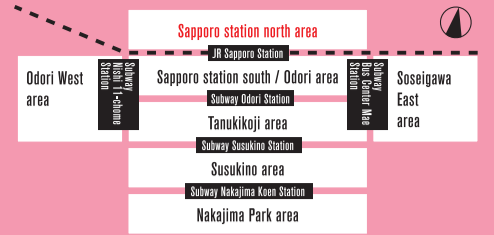

## Pioneering history, student town, vast campus

The Hokkaido University campus, famous for the phrase, "Boys, be ambitious," stretches to the north of JR Sapporo Station, and is a place where you can still see the scenery reminiscent of those pioneering days. Walking around Hokkaido University (a.k.a. Hokudai), one can sense three ambitions, the "pioneering ambition" of the people who gathered in Sapporo with great ideas for Hokkaido, the "dairy ambition" of foreigners who came to Hokkaido from Europe and the U.S. to pioneer the land and share their skills and culture, and the "continuing ambition" of the students and researchers who studied and took up challenges at Hokkaido University. Feel these three ambitions that are the culmination of the generosity and challenging spirit of Hokkaido residents, who say, "It'll work out somehow, let's just give it a try," and the charm of Hokkaido's rich and tasty agricultural products.

### Café de gohan

You can enjoy a wide variety of menu items, soft serve ice cream made from Hokudai milk, and original tea developed jointly with Hokudai students and LUPICIA Co., Ltd.



### Experimental farm No.1

You can enjoy the view of pastures that sit just in front of urban buildings—a contrasting landscape that is unique to Hokudai.



### CAFE de JIKAN

The stylish building is based on the motif of Sapporo Agricultural College's Farm No. 2, an important cultural asset, and the interior is relaxing.



### ●Eateries within Hokkaido University

Hokkaido University has several cafeterias and cafés. "12 Café de Gohan," located right next to the main gate of Hokkaido University, offers a variety of menus from breakfast to dinner.

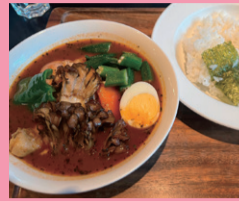
On sunny days, be sure to sit out on the terrace.

The original goods sold at the store are highly recommended as souvenirs.

"10 Polus," located inside the Hokkaido University Museum, is a café that focuses on Hokkaido-made ingredients.

The "11 Hokudai Marche Café & Labo" serves Hokudai milk and its dairy products.

Each restaurant also offers dishes that make use of Hokudai brand ingredients on an irregular basis.



### ●Curry

The area around Hokkaido University is a fierce battleground for curry.

The first place to go for soup curry is the long-established "7 Picante Main Restaurant," where the combination of three types of soups and ingredients is a must for any visitor. "6 Curry Tamasii Destroyer" offers the most popular curry, "Nutto Minced Meat Curry." "3 Soup Curry Cocoro" serves bouillon and tomato soup curry. "Curry Terracotta" specializes in keema, roux, and soup curry.

Aigake, where you can choose two or three kinds of curry, is also fun!

"Spice" is also a must stop for traditional North Indian curry prepared by an Indian chef.

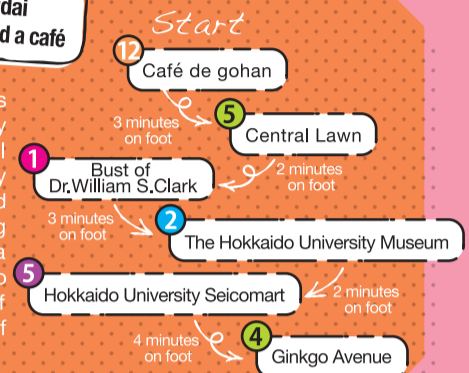


Enjoy nature and breakfast at Hokudai Refresh yourself with a morning walk and a café
