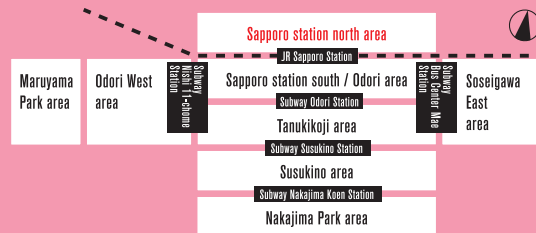

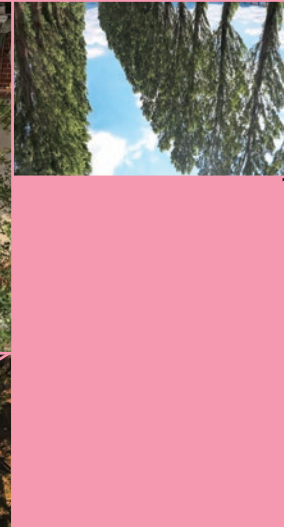

●Eateries within Hokkaido University

Hokkaido University has several cafeterias and cafés. "11 Café de Gohan," located right next to the main gate of Hokkaido University, offers a variety of menus from breakfast to dinner.

On sunny days, be sure to sit out on the terrace.

The original goods sold at the store are highly recommended as souvenirs.

"9 Polus," located inside the Hokkaido University Museum, is a café that focuses on Hokkaido-made ingredients.

The "10 Hokudai Marche Café & Labo" serves Hokudai milk and its dairy products. Each restaurant also offers dishes that make use of Hokudai brand ingredients on an irregular basis.



●Curry

The area around Hokkaido University is a fierce battleground for curry.

The first place to go for soup curry is the long-established "6 Picante Main Restaurant," where the combination of three types of soups and ingredients is a must for any visitor. "5 Curry Tamasii Destroyer" offers the most popular curry, "Nutto Minced Meat Curry." "3 Soup Curry Cocoro" serves bouillon and tomato soup curry. "Curry Terracotta" specializes in keema, roux, and soup curry.

Aigake, where you can choose two or three kinds of curry, is also fun!

"Spice" is also a must stop for traditional North Indian curry prepared by an Indian chef.



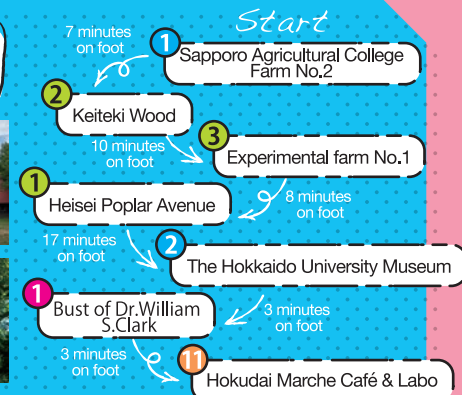

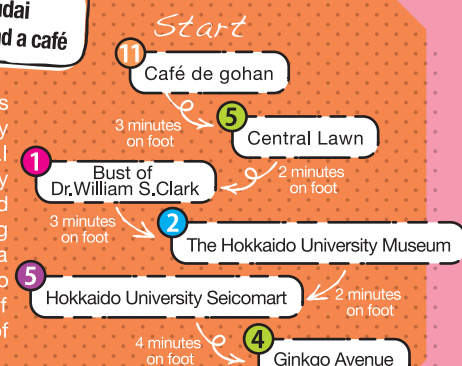


Enjoy nature and breakfast at Hokudai Refresh yourself with a morning walk and a café
