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### Sapporo TV Tower

From the TV tower, you can enjoy a panoramic view of Odori Park, which has been straightened and improved. Souvenirs are also available, so feel free to stop by.

Although only available on weekdays, the parlor and observation deck on the 19th floor of City Hall is a hidden gem known by locals.

The central area of Sapporo is divided into a grid pattern around Odori Park and the Sosei River. Addresses are also divided into south and north based on Odori Park, and east and west based on the Sosei River, which divides the city center into north and south, is the bustling center of the city center, where events such as the Lila Festival, beer gardens, Autumn Fest featuring Hokkaido and Sapporo cuisine, White Illumination in winter, and the world-famous Snow Festival are held on a seasonal basis. The Sosei River divides the city into east and west, and a walk along the lush green riverside path will lead you to the history of Sapporo and its art works. The best way to enjoy the Sapporo Station South/Odori area is to stroll around above and below ground, and to view Sapporo on a grid from the TV Tower, JR Tower, the cafe restaurant on the 19th floor of Sapporo City Hall, and other tall buildings in the city center. Furthermore, there is a 1.9 km straight underground space from Sapporo Station to Odori and Susukino, allowing visitors to enjoy the Odori neighborhood comfortably even on rainy and snowy days!

● A store with a great view

In this neighborhood of lush greenery in the heart of Sapporo, I recommend restaurants where you can enjoy the seasonal scenery and night views. At "1 Akarenga Terrace" near the Akarenga Government Building, the excellent French restaurant "LA BRIQUE" and "Restaurant MINAMI" or the calm atmosphere of the food court on the 3rd floor are good places to eat. If you want to enjoy Odori Park and the TV Tower, the popular French restaurant "Le Mansa" at "Le Trois," "Marumi Coffee" at "Marumi Sapporo Main Store," and "6 TOKUMITSU COFFEE Cafe & Beans Odori Branch" are also prime locations.



● Lunch Spots

"DONGURI," "COLOMBO," "Hinode Soba".... Cheap, euphonic, and tasty lunch places in an office district alley.  
"2 Donguri" has a fun lineup of savory breads such as chikuwa-pan, and recently, large onigiri (rice balls) have been gaining in popularity.  
"3 Colombo" is a long-established restaurant that serves authentic curry with roux sauce. You can feel their dedication for fine ingredients and quality of their cutlets and hamburgers, not to mention their service of adding more curry roux.  
"9 Hinode Soba", a stand-up restaurant, is popular for its hot soba and udon noodles that fill the stomachs and hearts of busy people. The cold ramen (chilled ramen noodles) in summer is also addictive!
