# Experience the grid city with a

## view of Odori Park and the Sosei River

The central area of Sapporo is divided into a grid pattern around Odori Park and the Sosei River. Addresses are also divided into south and north based on Odori Park, and east and west based on the Sosei River

Odori Park, which divides the city center into north and south, is the bustling center of the city center. where events such as the Lilac Festival, beer gardens. Autumn Fest featuring Hokkaido and Sapporo cuisine, White Illumination in winter, and the world-famous Snow Festival are held on a seasonal basis.

The Sosei River divides the city into east and west, and a walk along the lush green riverside path will lead you to the history of Sapporo and its art works.

The best way to enjoy the Sapporo Station South/Odori area is to stroll around above and below ground, and to view Sapporo on a grid from the TV

#### A 1.9 km straight underground space connecting Sapporo Station to Susukino

The underground pedestrian space allows one to walk comfortably through the city even on rainy or

snowy days, while enjoying shopping and dining in the adjacent buildings.



#### **JR TOWER Observatory T38**

At JR Tower Observatory T38, visitors can enjoy the night view created by the city's neon lights, as well as sweets and original cocktails at the attached cafe.

#### •A store with a great view

In this neighborhood of lush greenery in the heart of Sapporo, I recommend restaurants where you can enjoy the seasonal scenery and night views. At "1 Akarenga Terrace" near the Akarenga Government Building, the excellent French restaurant "LA BRIQUE" and "Restaurant MINAMI" or the calm atmosphere of the food court on the 3rd floor are good places to eat.

If you want to enjoy Odori Park and the TV Tower, the popular French restaurant "Le Mansa" at "Le Trois," "Marumi Coffee" at "Marui Imai Sapporo Main Store," and TOKUMITSU COFFEE Cafe & Beans Odori Branch at 3 ODORI BISSE" are also prime locations.

#### Lunch Spots



"DONGURI," "COLOMBO," "Hinode Soba".... Cheap, euphonic, and tasty lunch places in an office district alley.

2 Donguri" has a fun lineup of savory breads such as chikuwa-pan, and recently, large onigiri (rice balls) have been gaining in popularity.

2 Colombo" is a long-established restaurant that serves authentic curry with roux sauce. You can feel their dedication for fine ingredients and quality of their cutlets and hamburgers, not to mention their service of adding more curry roux. Hinode Soba", a stand-up restaurant, is popular for its hot soba and udon noodles that fill the stomachs and hearts of busy people. The cold ramen (chilled

ramen noodles) in summer is also addictive!
