The lush green park is also home to the Hoheikan, a historical building, Kitara, a world-class concert hall dedicated to music, the Hokkaido Museum of Literature, an astronomical observatory, a gymnasium, tennis courts, and the Kogumaza children's purpet theater, making it a central park where children and adults alike can spend time in a variety of ways.

The area along the Kamokamo River, the origin of Nakajima Park, is characterized by its beautiful seasonal expressions, such as therry blossoms in spring and autumn

Shobu Pond in the park was created as a lumber yard to accumulate lumber cut down in the upper reaches of the lahikari River during the settlement of the srea. The Shobu pond is a pathway for citizens enjoying boating in summer and for animals in winter as the surface of the water freezes over.

Nakajima Park was originally an islet surrounded by the Toyohira River and its tributary, the Kamokamo River.

There are great places such as "OAgt", famous for its rice sandwiches "Kome San®" made with Hokkaido rice and fermented foods, "Hasamiya," excellent New York-style sandwiches using homemade ingredients, "L'atsuya traiteur," a deli known for its seasonal vegetables and European-style side dishes, "Kinseido," a long-established bento store that focuses on purchasing the best ingredients.





Famous restaurants

The Nakajima Park area is home to a variety of famous restaurants that are frequented by food connoisseurs from all over the country in search of the best of Japanese cuisine

Reservations are required for "Nukumi," which offers seasonal Japanese cuisine beautiful vessels, and "Shimo Yamite Na Izuru," which treats diners to a free-flowing fusion of Hokkaido seafood and other dishes. This is a gastronomic experience that you won't want to miss.

'Ohkami Soup" is a specialty miso ramen restaurant that specializes only in miso ramen, so be prepared to wait in line for a bowl of their special soup!
