Old maps show that the Odori West area was the "edge" of Sapporo's development and the boundary between villages. A little further west is Maruyama, and a little further north is an area called Soen, but these areas "do not yet" have a name.

The retro streetscape with streetcars and the nostalgic multi-tenant buildings are impressive. In the rooms of these buildings, there are general stores and cafes with unique retro atmospheres where you can experience the craftsmanship and artwork of artists and literary works.

Museums and lawns surrounded by nature are also attractive places to take a breather, forget about everyday life, and be inspired, whether it is on a sunny, rainy, or snowy day. It is notable as an "old" yet "new" area of Sapporo.

## Space1-15

From the outside, it looks like just an apartment. But actually ... This mysterious building, with its unique stores in every room, is like Kowloon Castle. Once you unlock the art lock by pressing the chime of the store you are interested in, you will find a variety of stores of all genres: for living, making things, relaxing, eating, fashion, handicrafts, and for learning, etc. The concierge's top pick is Takechasu Records, a record shop open only on weekends. "Records" are experiencing a resurgence in popularity around the world, especially among young people, as the widespread use of smartphones has brought back the lo-fi style of music appreciation. Why don't you come and find your favorite record?





## **Hokkaido Governor's Official Residence**

The Western-style building seen through the trees in the lush garden was built by Mitsui Zaibatsu in 1936 and is marked on old maps as the "Mitsui Club." In 1953, it became the "Hokkaido Governor's Residence." and its spacious grounds also house the "Hokkaido Migishi Kotaro Museum of Art. It is also used for filming movies and TV dramas, and if you are lucky, you may see Ezo-risu, Hokkaido squirrels and wild birds. The area is also popular as an Instagram-worthy spot. The babbling brook and sunlight filtering through the trees are also pleasant, and the area is a popular resting place for citizens who enjoy forest bathing and reading books on the spacious green lawn.





#### Sweets




